#### • **TOUCHING** \_\_\_\_\_.

*A man with leprosy came to (Jesus) and begged him on his knees, "If you are willing, you can make me clean."*

Mark 1:40

*Filled with compassion, Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man...Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cured. Mark 1:41-42*

#### • **BEFRIENDING** \_\_\_\_\_.

*While Jesus was having dinner at Matthew's house, many tax collectors and "sinners" came and ate with him and his disciples. Matthew 9:10*

*When the Pharisees saw this, they asked his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and 'sinners'?" Jesus said, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick...For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners."
