Acts 2:42-47 (NLT) All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer. A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need. They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity— all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.

Matthew 22:35-40 (NLT) (A Pharisee), an expert in religious law, tried to trap him with this question: "Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?" Jesus replied, "'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."

Acts 2:46 (NLT) They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity—

Acts 2:42 (NLT) All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer.

Fellowship: *koinonia* - (*koinonos*); *partnership*, i.e. (literal) *participation*, or (social) *intercourse*... Strong's Greek & Hebrew Dictionary.

John 13:34 (NLT) Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other.

Romans 12:10 (NLT) ...take delight in honoring each other.

Romans 15:7 (NLT) ...accept each other just as Christ has accepted you...

Galatians 5:13 (NLT) ...serve one another in love.

Ephesians 4:32 (NLT) ...be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another...

1 Thessalonians 5:11 (NLT) ...encourage each other and build each other up...

Hebrews 10:24 (NLT) ...motivate one another to acts of love and good works.

1 Peter 3:8 (NLT) ...Sympathize with each other...

Acts 2:43 (NLT) A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders.

Acts 2:44-45 (NLT) And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need.

Acts 2:46-47 (NIV) ...They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

Acts 2:47 (MSG) ...People in general liked what they saw...

John 13:35 (NLT) Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples."

Matthew 18:20 (NLT) (Jesus) For where two or three gather together as my followers, I am there among them.
