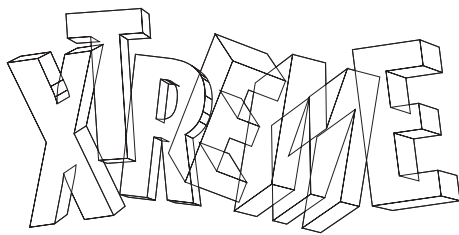


## CURRENT SERIES
